# Overview

In response to customer feedback, Mastercard is temporarily delaying the introduction of refund transaction authorization requirements. The revised Standards that previously published with this bulletin announcement are also delayed. Mastercard will publish revised Standards on this subject in conjunction with a future release.

Customers are strongly encouraged to perform refund transaction authorization message testing to ensure their capability to support the upcoming changes. Test scripts will be available in Release 19.Q2.
